Launching the NET-EUCEN network enlargement campaign

The Network of European Stakeholders for Enhance User Centricity in eGovernance project **NET-EUCEN** was set up in 2010 to create, animate and manage a network of stakeholders in the domains of Governance and Policy Modelling. NET-EUCEN extends to all European countries and includes partners with relevant knowledge on mass fruition of on-line service and eInclusion policies.



The network broadens along the entire supply chain of the Service for Users (**S4U**) and addresses the objectives of **sharing common practices** and working methods amongst the 23 organisations that originally subscribed to NET-EUCEN vision. Further objective are those of assessing innovative **application scenarios** and foster their implementation in the European member States by supporting a multidisciplinary approach to the advances in innovative ICT solutions for citizens, Public Administrations and large communities.

Listing already 23 partners from 16 different European Countries, the target at hand is to ensure access to the network for a growing number of associate members; the final aim of NET-EUCEN is to foster a self-sustainable network including at least four hundreds of Organisations, thus to have a global reach and achieve economies of scale in carrying out its remit.

The network will be presented to the whole stakeholders supply chain during the **ICT2010 event** organised by the European Commission and hosted by the Belgian Presidency of the European Union in September 2010 where a wide offer of opportunities and procedures will also be unveiled.
